We have an annual 'Anti bullying week in which we teach and learn what bullying is, how bullying impacts on our peers and how bullying should be addressed. In answer to Question 8 (the school supports the wider development of children). Enrichments, enhancements and extracurricular activities are important to the ethos of our school as we most concerned with developing the whole child. We report these numerous activities in our half termly newsletter, our website diary references these activities on a weekly basis and we offer daily after school activity clubs across the year.
